## Planning Document for Bachelor of Applied Science: Minor in Arts

#### Student Instructions:

There are two options for Engineering students wanting to pursue a Minor in Arts – an 18-credit or a 30-credit minor. For both options, you are responsible for proposing a plan of courses you want to take. When determining what courses to take, students reference the Major or Minor Program listed under each subject in the UBC Calendar for the Faculty of Arts. All courses in your proposed plan must be courses an Arts student could use toward their Major in that subject.

On this document, create a course plan in Part B based on the courses a student in the Bachelor of Arts would take in their major for your intended specialization. Meet with the department advisor of your intended specialization to confirm the course plan includes only courses that would be used in the Arts Major, and is academically sound, and have them sign Part C.

#### **Department Advisor Instructions:**

Students in the Bachelor of Applied Science do not follow a rigid course list for Minors in Arts. Instead, they are allowed to propose a course plan that consists of courses in a single subject or field of specialization based on what a Bachelor of Arts student would take in a Major in that subject.

Please ensure that the courses the student is proposing in Part B could be used to fulfill Major requirements in your department, and the course plan is academically sound. Considerations may want to be taken for courses that will be restricted from the student, or if they will have pre-requisites required. If the course plan is approved, please sign Part B.

### Requirements:

18-credit Minor - complete a minimum of 18 upper-level credits (300+) in a single subject or field of specialization.

30-credit Minor - complete 30 credits in a single subject or specialization, 18 of these credits must be upper-lever credits (300+).
